Responsibilities:

- Locating using either Digi-track or Subsite locating systems, preferably both.
- Operate equipment, including, but not limited to directional drills, locating systems, trencher, backhoe, excavators.
- The ability to work safely, with or without supervision.
- Locator must be knowledgeable with all typical safety procedures and always apply them.
- Assist in the loading/unloading of equipment and supplies needed for daily work assignments, settingup of worksite traffic and safety controls and properly securing work area.
- Hand dig with shovels, picks, digging bars to expose located utilities, access u/g vaults and pedestals, and complete trenches.
- Operate jackhammers, air knives, pneumatic boring equipment (compressors & missiles), powered augers and trenching vibratory drop plow.
- Fully restore worksite at completion of daily work, refill trenches and holes, tamp soil, replant any plants or shrubs that were disturbed during our construction, place temporary asphalt on streets where excavations have been performed.
- When required and if appropriately licensed and authorized, drive or operate construction equipment used on the jobsite to complete daily work assignments.
- Must have good communication skills and a positive attitude.
- Ability to work in a fast-paced environment.
- Clean and maintain all company vehicles and equipment assigned for use.
- Able to perform physical tasks for the entire assigned work shift.
- Willingness to work shifts as assigned, including daily overtime when necessary

Minimum Qualifications:

- Experience with locating & verify all utilities before construction.
- At a minimum, the position requires a good working knowledge of utility construction; familiarity with Horizontal Directional Drills, ability to identify and troubleshoot problems. Individuals must be able to read prints and have knowledge of the underground processes.
