- Operate Directional boring equipment.
- Operate locator system.
- Locate & verify all utilities before construction.
- Maintain and/or repair our customers facilities.
- Be able to identify and troubleshoot problems.
- Be able to read prints and have knowledge of the underground process.
- Ensure proper care in the use and maintenance of equipment, tools, and supplies.
- Adhere to strict safety standards while ensuring the highest quality of work is completed efficiently and timely.
- Assist in the loading/unloading of equipment and supplies needed for daily work assignments, setting-up of worksite traffic and safety controls and properly securing work area.
- Hand dig with shovels, picks, digging bars to expose located utilities, access u/g vaults and pedestals, and complete trenches.
- Operate jackhammers, air knives, pneumatic boring equipment (compressors & missiles), and powered augers.
- Fully restore worksite at completion of daily work, refill trenches and holes, tamp soil, replant any plants or shrubs that were disturbed during our construction, place temporary asphalt on streets where excavations have been performed.
- When required and if appropriately licensed and authorized, drive or operate construction equipment used on the jobsite to complete daily work assignments.
- Clean and maintain all company vehicles and equipment assigned for use.
- Able to perform physical tasks for the entire assigned work shift.
- Willingness to work shifts as assigned, including daily overtime when necessary
